

SITEBUILDER TUTORIAL

1. Create SWF and Html Code in KoolMoves

- a) Open KoolMoves.
- b) Create your animation.
- c) Export Movie (File > Export Movie > Add Flash Movie to Web Page Wizard).
- d) Select Poor html skill level, Yahoo Site Builder for html editor.
- e) Press Next. Press Next again. Display Web Page Code page is now active.
- f) Create swf file or select swf file.
- g) Press Copy to Clipboard to save the code displayed. Open Notepad and paste the code.
- h) Example of code is shown below:

2. Add Code to SiteBuilder

- a) Open SiteBuilder.
- b) Select File > New Site or Open Site.
- c) Copy swf and AC_RunActiveContent.js (found in KoolMoves / IE Active X Fix folder) to the folder just created by SiteBuilder or to an existing folder.
- d) Right-click on blank area in Index.html and select HTML.
- e) Into the top box (HTML Head), copy/paste from above code or Notepad file you saved:
<script src="AC_RunActiveContent.js" type="text/javascript"></script>
- f) Press OK.
- g) Select Insert > Code Elements > HTML.
- h) Copy/paste code from the Notepad file you saved starting with <script type="text/javascript"> ...
- i) Press OK.
- j) Drag the blue box larger so it is as large as the flash movie.
- k) Test movie with File > Preview in Browser.
- l) Make sure the swf and AC_RunActiveContent.js file are published to server.
